

HOWARD MATTOS FREE THROW SHOOTOUT 24-25

Background:

Howard Mattos was a coach in Cupertino Hoops who tragically passed on during a $5^{th}/6^{th}$ Boy's Division team practice. To remember Coach Howard, the league created a FREE THROW SHOOTOUT in his honor.

How It Works:

Prior to Tournament Day, coaches should conduct a free throw shooting contest for their respective teams. The winner of the team contest will represent their team at the shootout on tournament day.

Mar 1st:

456 Girls - Teams 61 thru 67; 1 from each team

Mar 2nd:

45 Boys - Teams 1 thru 10; <u>1 from each team</u> 678 Girls - Teams 51 thru 60; 1 from each team

Mar 8th:

678 Boys D4/5 - Teams 28, 30, 31, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39; 1 from each team

Mar 9th

678 Boys D1/2/3 - Teams 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 29, 32; 1 from each team

On Tournament Day, the representatives for each team will take part in the free throw shootout by division. Awards are given to the top place finishers. The shootout rules are as follows:

- Each contestant takes 10 consecutive shots
- Best of 10 shots wins
- In the event of ties:
 - 1st Tie Breaker: 5 shots
 2nd Tie Breaker: 3 shots
 - O 3rd Tie Breaker and on: 1 shot
- If a contestant is unable to attend the tournament shootout for any reason, the coach may choose to either have a backup or no representative.
